Parking Lot Reminder

We want to keep our parking lot presentable. Make sure to have your Parking Sticker in your car at all times and if you have a guest, come to our office for a visitor's pass. We have some vehicles that appear to be used as storage and/or being stored in our property. This is unacceptable; cars being stored are subject to being towed. In addition, unregistered cars are subject to immediate towing. Don't forget about our promise to keep our marina clean. During our dock walks, we will be checking for the maintenance of your boat and slip area. If you have any questions please contact us.



"The Clean Marinas program is an ongoing endeavor, by a marina industry alliance, determined to provide environmentally clean facilities and protect the states' coastal and inland waters from pollution through compliance of best management practices."

Checklist:

- All ropes and hoses are kept out of the water to avoid algae growth.
- No items are permitted to be stored along the fingers of the slip or behind dock box.
- Only items allowed on the finger are a mat and a stepping stool. (stool isn't used for storage)
- Boat is clean and has good appearance. (boat is not used for storage)

Summer is the best time of the year and spending it by the water makes it even better; unfortunately, it's mosquitos' favorite time of the year as well. We are very aware of our current situation with mosquitos and we are working with Vector Control to fix this issue as it is affecting everyone. Fight the Bite!

• Wear light colored pants and long-sleeved shirts, when outdoors

• Apply repellent containing DEET, Picaridin, IR3535 or Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus to clothing and exposed skin - When using sunscreen, apply repellents after applying sunscreen.

• Try to stay indoors during dawn and dusk

According to the U.S. Coast Guard, 85 percent of drowning victims in recreational boating accidents were not wearing a life jacket

"Wear It!"

identifies the top 5 excuses not to wear a life jacket.

 "I have life jackets on board." Having life jackets on board the vessel is not enough. Accidents happen too fast to put on a stowed life jacket.
"I'm a strong swimmer." Even a strong swimmer needs to wear a life jacket. During an emergency, clothing can become heavy or waterlogged while in the water.



3. "It's too hot and doesn't look cool." Old-fashioned, bulky orange life jackets have been replaced with new styles, like inflatable life jackets that may resemble a pair of suspenders or a belt pack. These are much cooler in the warmer weather.

4. "It gets in the way." There are life jacket styles available for any recreational water activity – fishing, water sports, hunting, paddling and more. There are even styles for pets!

5. "Nothing is going to happen to me." Face it, accidents happen. Boating can be a fun, safe and enjoyable activity, but when the "Wear It!" message is ignored, the consequences can be grim.
